ALAYNE FLEISCHMANN, a BC lawyer, while working in quality control at a large financial company in New York, first witnessed, and then tried to stop what she described as "massive criminal securities fraud" in the bank's mortgage operations. She made repeated attempts at multiple levels to address real concerns about risky purchases but was blocked, with even a "no emails" rule by her superior.



Ultimately, this and similar practices in other banks led to the subprime mortgage crisis in 2007, which sparked the global financial crisis, impacting millions of people, and has been called one of the most significant white-collar crimes in US history. Alayne Fleishmann's efforts and paper trail led to the Department of Justice calling on her as a witness and levying a \$9 billion fine on the bank. She credits her actions to her small-town values growing up, like "you're not allowed to steal". "If we don't start speaking up, then this really is all we're going to get: the biggest financial cover-up in history."

Alayne Fleischmann demonstrated extreme courage at great personal and professional risk in pursuing justice for the bank clients she was serving.

Raoul Wallenberg Day pays tribute to the courageous actions by people engaged in selfless acts of civil courage in the spirit of Raoul Wallenberg and Chiune Sugihara, who each rescued thousands of Jews during World War II.
