

FILM: ZERO TO ZERO – Filmed over 15 months, this gripping one-hour documentary offers an unfiltered look at what it's like to be a healthcare worker in the grips of the Covid-19 pandemic. It follows the staff of a hospital from the moment they admit their first Covid-19 patient in June 2020, till after the third wave. Uniquely, it was filmed by a healthcare worker with unprecedented access to the hospital frontline. It deals with patients during life and death situations, but the focus remains on the indomitable strength of the human spirit. The film humanizes the frontline workers, showing the world a glimpse of what they have had to face. (South Africa, October 2021)
